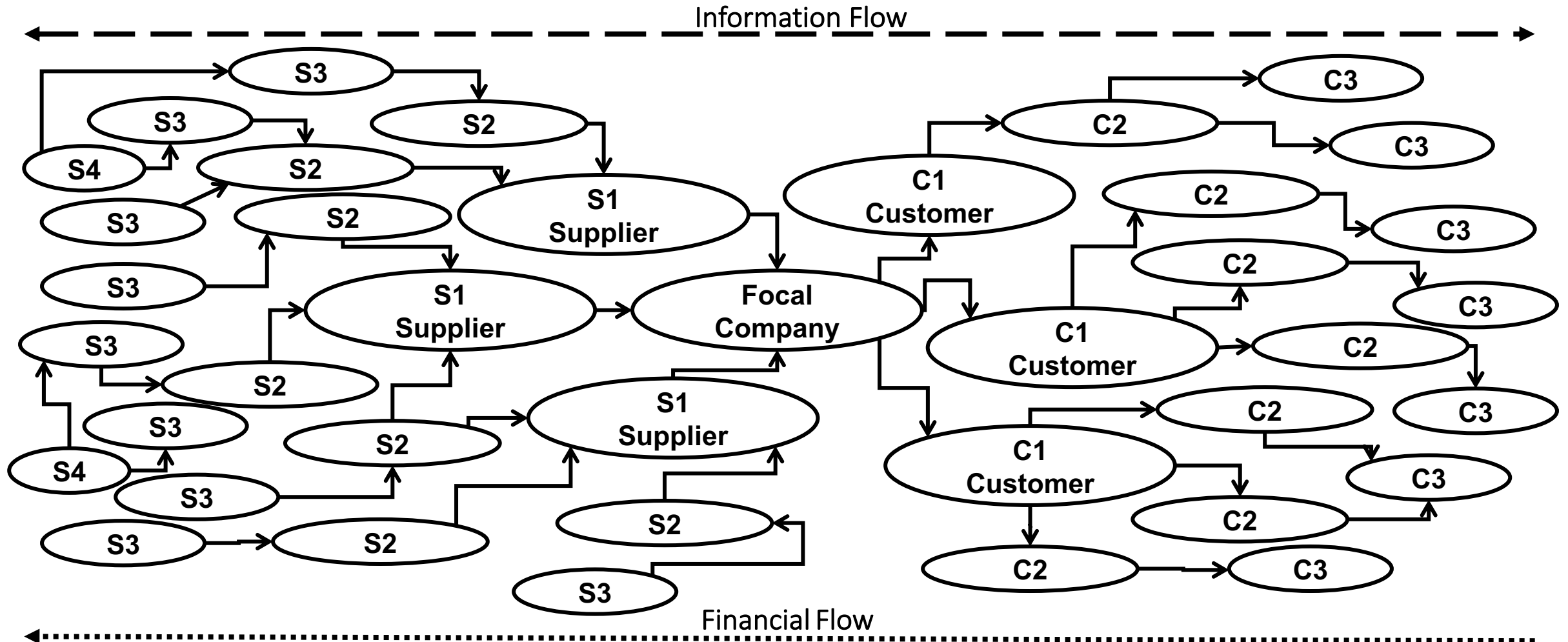
Supply Chain Financing is:

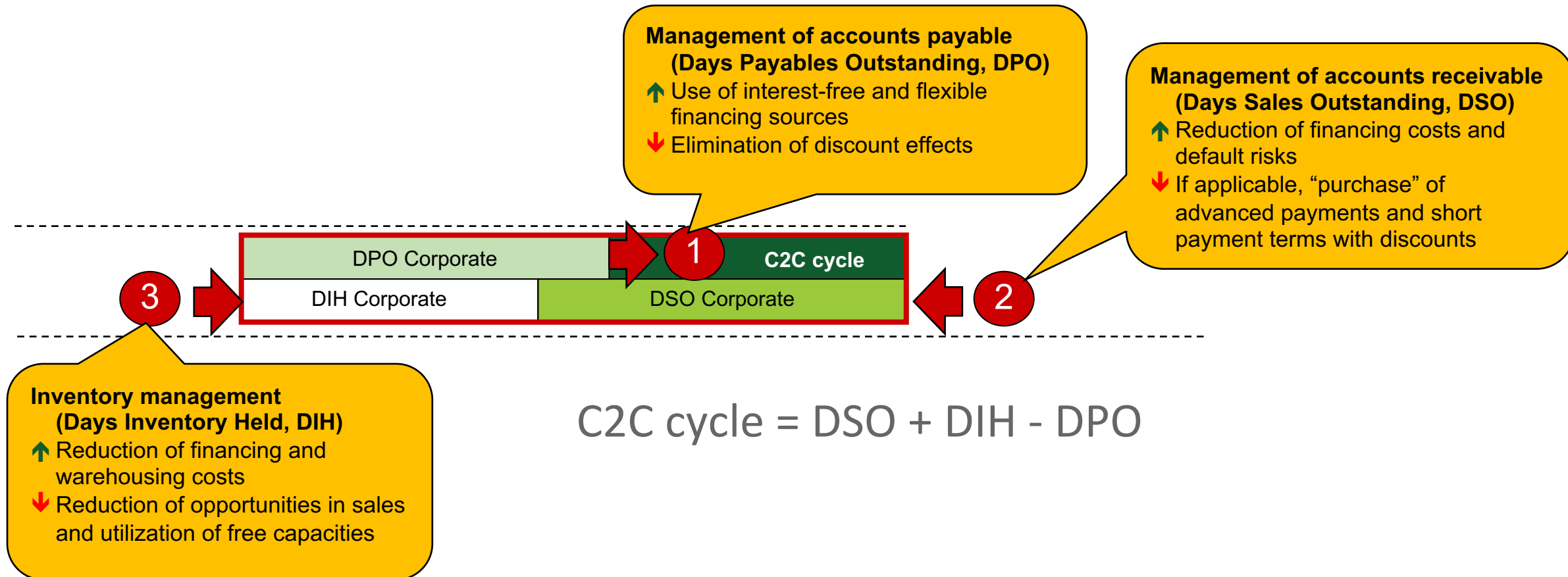
Fund the Growth

Building Financially Sustainable Supply Chain Network

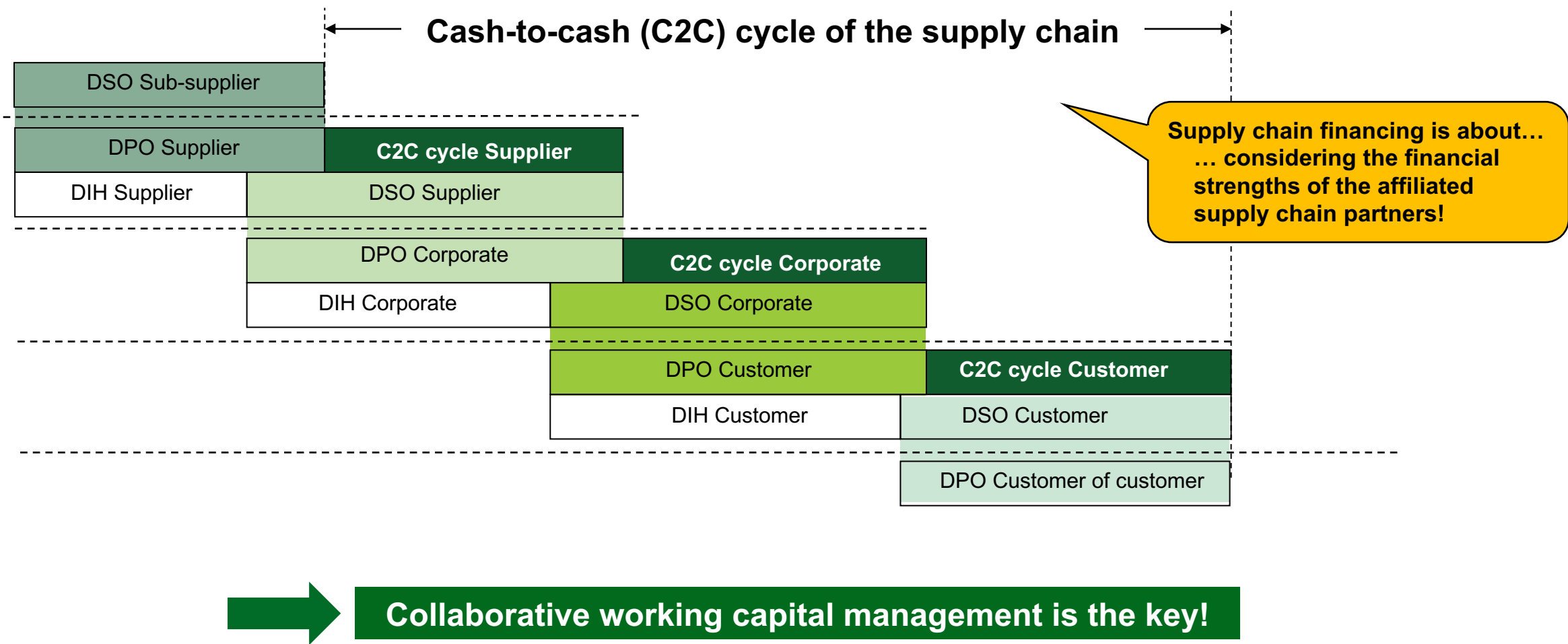


Supply chain financing is about managing the cash-to-cash (C2C) cycle:

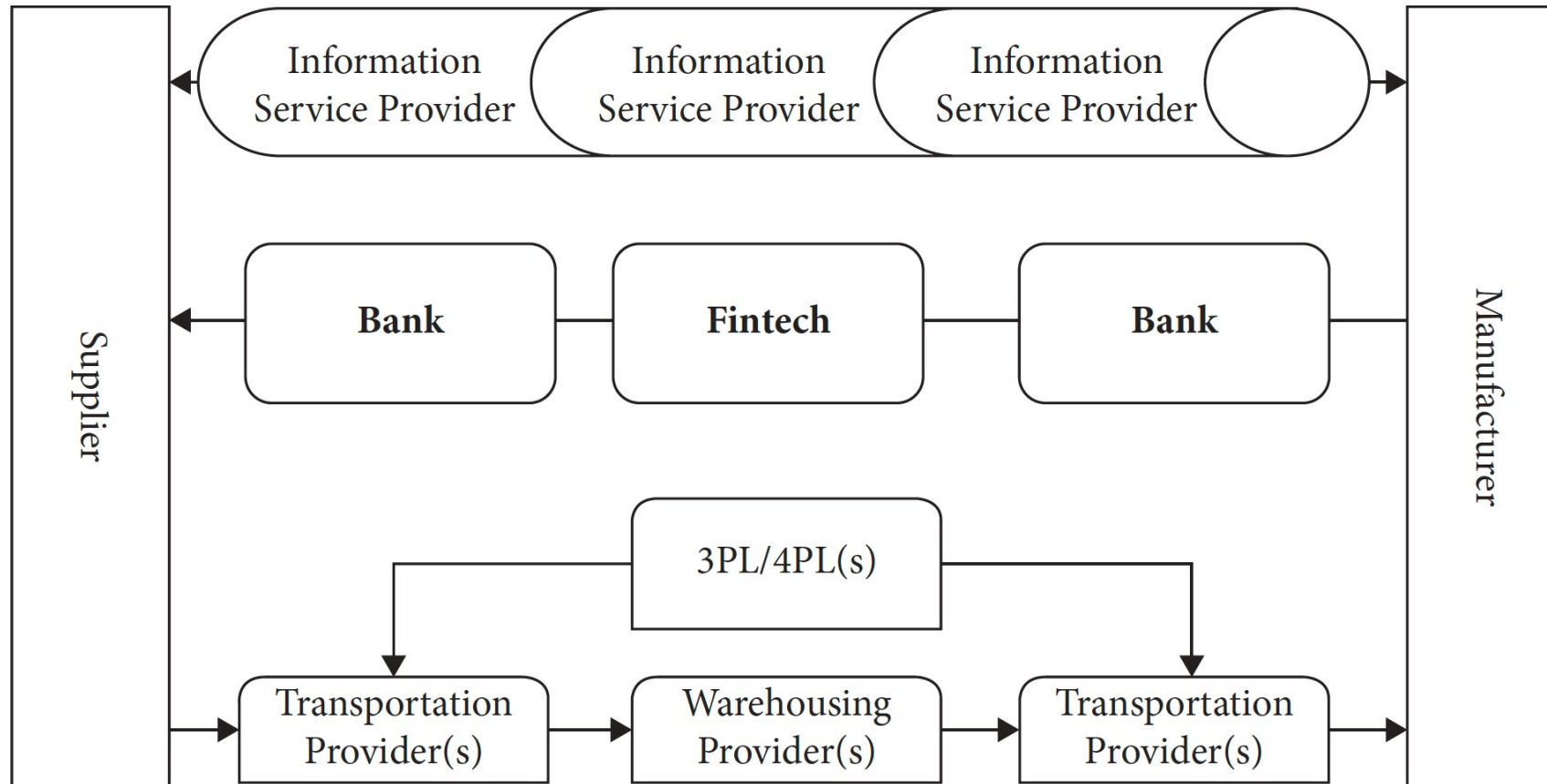
Consideration of trade-offs from an individual company perspective

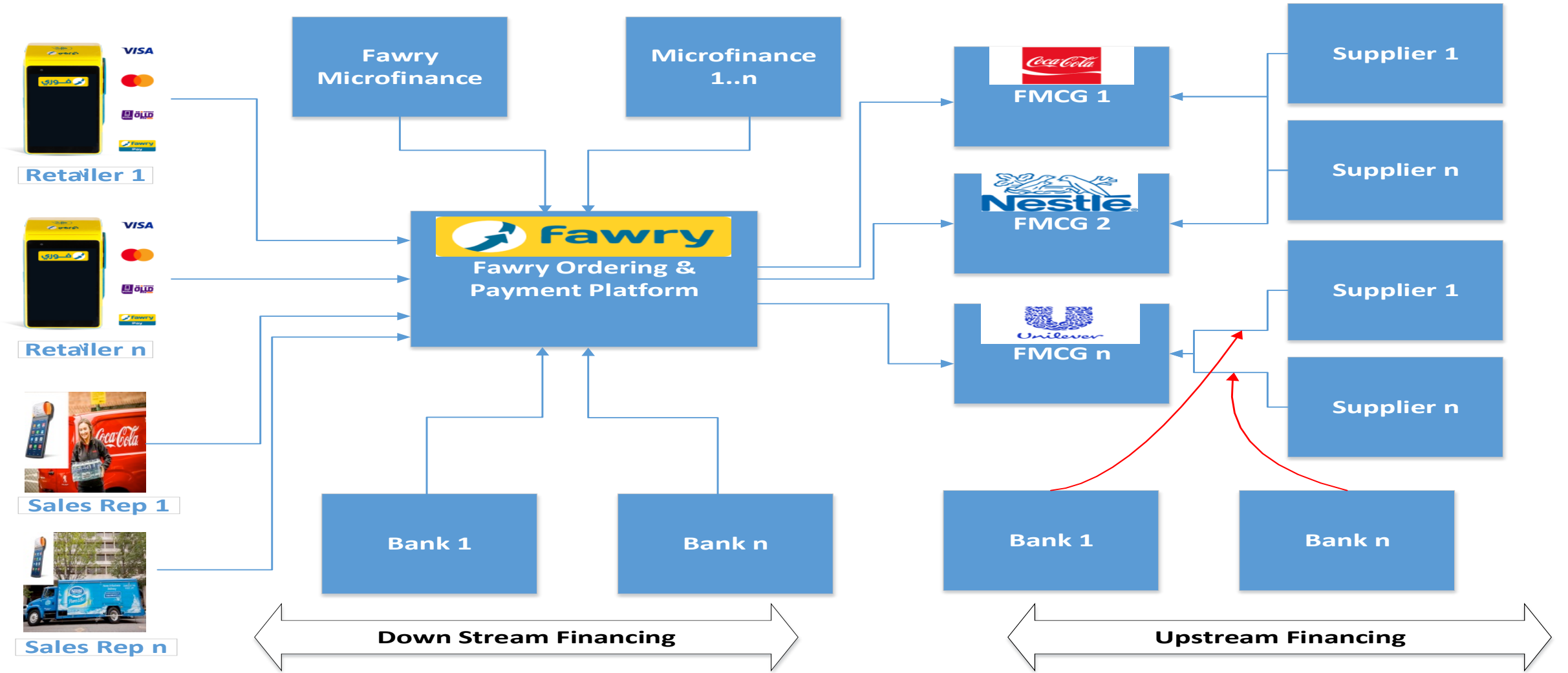

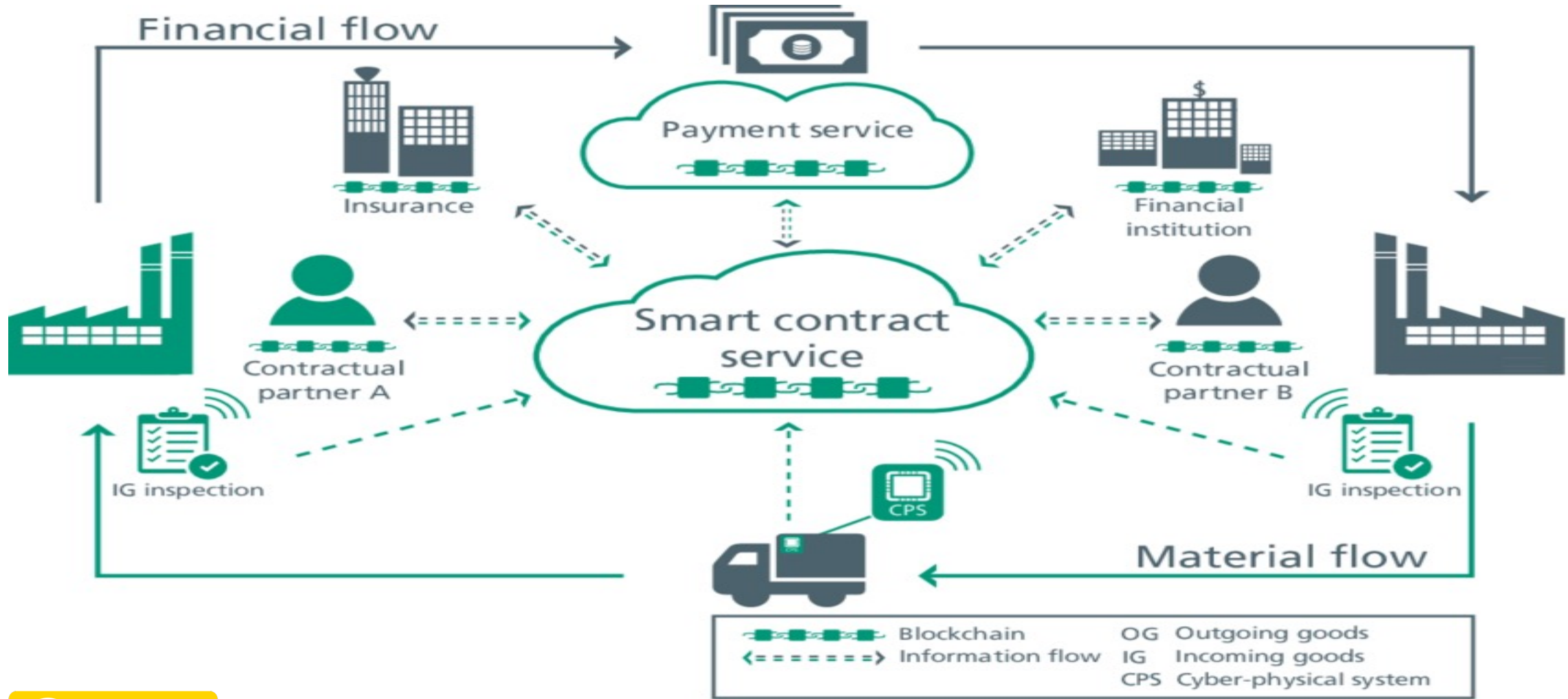
