

**M. Randall Levin** joined the ASU Foundation for A New American University in 2013 as senior vice president and managing director of assets.

In his position, Levin will utilize his commercial real estate experience as a developer, architect and real estate broker in determining strategic positioning, implementation of land and vertical developments, trade partnering, and real estate disposition and/or repositioning for new and future real estate assets.
